

Instructions for Initial Consultation with Dr. Bordbar

Bring the following items when coming to the appointment:

1. **valid** provincial Health Card (**OHIP Card**)
2. current **medications** or an updated list and a list of previous medications
3. copies of relevant **documents** such as:
 - previous assessments by **Health Care Professionals** (Physicians, Psychologist, etc.)
 - **school** report cards, IEP
 - psycho-educational assessments etc.

Note 1: Please arrive a few minutes **before** the appointment time and **present** all the necessary documents to the front desk staff. **Allow 1.5-2 hours for the initial consultation.**

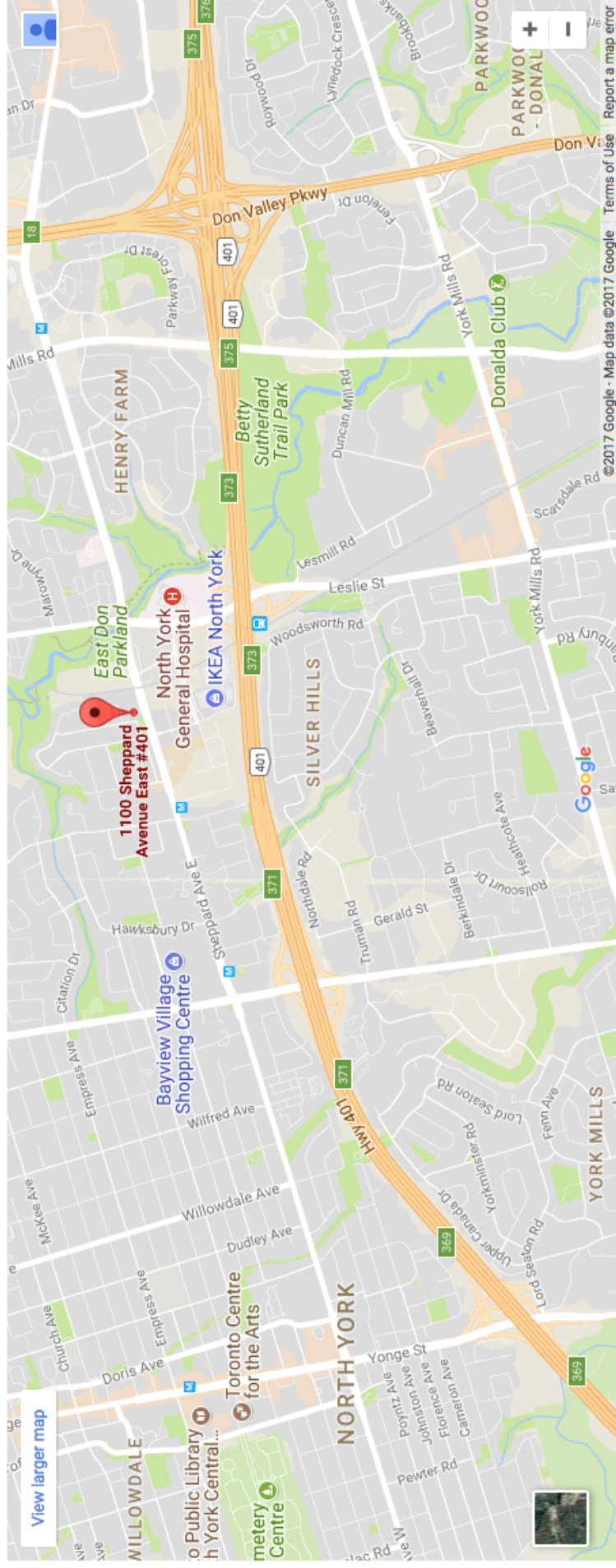
Note 2: To avoid any administrative fee, at least **24 business-hour notice (excluding weekends and statutory holidays)** is required to reschedule a confirmed appointment.

Notes 3: If patient/family does not speak English, an **interpreter** must accompany the patient to the appointment.

Note 4: Children & adolescents must be **accompanied by parent(s) or legal guardian(s).**
