CDA is a proud member of DANCE SAFE; ensuring all Ontario Dance Studios are operating according to government rules and regulations regarding COVID-19.

No dancers are to enter the dance studio if feeling ill. All dancers must complete a pre-screening and be dropped off & picked up on time. No parents are to enter at this time. All dancers must watch a safety video of how to enter and exit with their belongings. A tour can be pre-arranged. All dancers are to be 6ft apart at all times. All bathrooms are sanitized regularly and floors and dance barres between classes. We appreciate your commitment to our dancer's safety. ZOOM is an option for ALL classes; enjoy dancing at home until you feel ready to come back in person.

Pre-Primary (ages 2-3) 30 min class once per week. For many, it is their first experience with dance. The goal is for these young ones to have fun while learning a new skill. **Remember consistency is key for this age.** Coming every week will help their routine; PARENTS TO REMAIN IN THE ROOM FOR FIRST FEW CLASSES FOR THIS AGE..

It is recommended to register for Ballet for technique, it is the foundation of all dance. Bring a friend, have fun, and remember dance is for an active lifestyle and creative expression!

Primary dancers (ages 4-5, JK & SK age) 30 min classes. It is recommended at this age to register for 2 or more classes; all classes have been organized for only 8 per class and safe drop off & pick up. Jazz, Tap, Ballet, Acro, or Hip Hop.

Level 1,2, 3- Ages 6-13 Ballet, Jazz, Acro, Hip Hop, Musical Theatre, and Lyrical classes available.

Teen- Ages 13-17. Recreational teen dance classes available.

Payment options

All Fees are paid in the form of pre-authorized VISA/MasterCard. Any NSF fees or late fees will be charged an admin fee of \$35.

OPTION 1- Payments per Term: The first payment in September, the second in February.

OPTION 3- You may also choose to pay for the entire year's fees in full up front. There is a **discount of 10%!**

Additional Costs

\$45 REGISTRATION FEE, (plus HST) per family due at time of registration and is paid on an annual basis.

Costume deposits cqs are due at registration to secure your dancers spot in recital; this year Cheque only dated January 1st - \$80 deposit per class, per child. Costume Deposits are non-refundable. Any remaining balance of the costumes is due when costume is picked up in the Spring. Remaining Costume balance can

range from \$0-\$40. This can include, but is not limited to; seamstress/alteration fees and shipping fees.

Costumes for recreational dance range from \$80-\$150. Costumes will not go home with the dancer until all Costume fees are paid in full. No costume will be given if a dancer drops out, as we may have to replace that dancer in choreography. Competition costumes range from \$150 - \$300.

Refund Policy

Students are allowed an initial trial period of the **first two weeks**. If the student withdraws at this point, session fees will be fully refunded minus classes taken. If you are withdrawing from a class the office must receive written notice before the end of the initial two weeks otherwise no refund will be issued.

PLEASE NOTE: ALL Fees are **NOT refundable after** the second week of classes regardless of the circumstance.

Fees will **NOT** be refunded for classes already taken.

Registration and Costume Fees are **NOT** refundable.

✓ COVID 19 Protocols

The activities of CDA include, but are not limited to, a variety of dance, games, activities, and events. CDA will be implementing, as per public health guidelines, cohorts of no more than 8-20 people (including teachers) with under 50 people in the entire facility as per Ontario Government Framework for Reopening. Before each cohort's scheduled class or camp, equipment and room will be sanitized. Hand washing and sanitizing will be expected of each participant before and after activities.

CDA will be taking more health and safety precautions; Prior to the start of camp, or class, the parent/guardian will have to attest to their child(ren)'s good health and that neither the child(ren) nor any member of their immediate household has traveled within 14 days of the start of the child(ren)'s camp or class, that they are not exhibiting symptoms of Covid-19, and that they have not been in contact with anyone who has tested positive for Covid-19. In addition, the parent/guardian will be required to complete a screening questionnaire that will be send out for each child each day before arrival attesting to the child's good health, that they are not exhibiting symptoms of Covid-19 and that they have not been in contact with anyone who has tested positive for Covid-19. Each staff member will be required to complete an assessment form daily similar to the child assessment form.

Other precautions include: encouraging and enforcing more hand washing, more use of hand sanitizers, regular sanitizing of equipment, wiping down and disinfecting of doorknobs, washrooms, tables and high use areas with antibacterial wipes and/or spray, etc.

Any child or teacher that does not feel well for any reason should not attend camp or class, is to remain at home and CDA should be notified. Additionally, if any dancer or teacher is exhibiting any symptoms of the Coronavirus (Covid19) and/or tests positive for same, CDA is to be advised immediately. In such a circumstance, CDA will notify local public health authorities for further guidance and instructions. In taking these and other extra precautions, CDA is working to protect our dancers and teachers however there are still risks of being exposed and possibly contracting the Coronavirus (Covid-19) or possibly some other illness. I have read and understand the CDA activities and risk of exposure to the Coronavirus (Covid-19). Although we are taking the necessary precautions, and following Ontario Government Framework for Reopening at CDA, the risk of spreading Covid-19 still exists. I acknowledge and accept the risks that my child and/or members of my family in close contact (within 2 meters for more than 15 minutes) may be at risk of getting Coronavirus (Covid-19) with my child being enrolled. I have read and understand the policies set in place by CDA and

agree to release and forever discharge (agreeing to make no claim, and not to sue) and indemnify and hold harmless CDA and their respective owners, members, directors, officers, employees, contractors, agents, representatives, sub-contractors and volunteers (individually and collectively referred to as the "Released Parties") with respect to any and all claims related to contracting the Coronavirus (COVID-19) or any other illness and /or injury and any loss, bodily injury or damages associated from it which I, any family member or my child(ren) may suffer, arising out of any way related to him/her being enrolled at CDA.

CDA will continue to comply with Ontario Government protocols for COVID 19 and protocols outlined above may be changed as such.

✓ **DRESS CODE:**

It is mandatory that ALL students follow the dress code. Should a student arrive without the appropriate attire, the student will not be allowed to participate. This is for the safety of the dancer and co-operation of all students.

Attire:

Ages 3-5: Pink tank bodysuit, pink dance tights.

Ages 6- Adult: Black tank bodysuit, beige dance tights, black dance shorts optional, no shorts for ballet classes (except adult classes- comfortable clothing permitted), hip hop- comfortable black sweats, blank tanks & indoor running shoes.

Shoes:

All Ballet classes require proper pink leather ballet slippers (must be from dance store- check with instructor on first day of class if unsure)

Jazz, Jazz/Hip Hop & Musical Theater classes = jazz shoes (no laces),

Tap = There are many styles...please speak with instructor before purchasing shoes. (Dancers can participate in the first class without shoes).

Hair:

It is mandatory that ALL Students prior to arriving for class, prepare their hair in the following styles:

- Bun and or
- Pony tail

✓ **STUDIO POLICIES**

We recommend reading this section to your child.

NO visitors, or parents waiting due to Covid-19 protocols, please ensure arrival just before class time; and pick up promptly.

Classrooms are not to be used outside of scheduled/registered class time without prior permission from CDA management.

Parents are not allowed to enter the class unless they are invited in to watch for a special occasion.

All persons entering the studio are asked to PLEASE remove all outdoor shoes upon entry to the studio!! No outdoor footwear is allowed in the studio past the front. Many dancers are in bare feet.

Please respect classmates, teachers, volunteers and visitors while in attendance at the studio. ALL students are expected to conduct themselves professionally at all times. Disruptive behavior may result in disciplinary action up to and including removal from the program.

Food and Drink (with the exception of water) are not permitted in any class rooms. Changerooms closed as per COVID-19 Protocols; please arrive READY to dance. Sweat pants & Sweat shirt can be worn on top of your dance attire and taken off to be placed in your dance bag at the back of the studio. Each dancer will have a designated area for their dance bag.

Respect your studio, fellow dancers, parents, volunteers and instructors. CDA is a team. CDA is proud of our family friendly environment & we want you to be too!

✓ Parent Information

Parents are to be responsible of all dates, times and schedule events. It is the responsibility of the parent or adult student to be aware of all school activities, such as viewing days, recitals, extra classes, and or dates the school is open or closed as per emails, monthly Newsletters, and on the CDA website. It is the parents responsibility to regularly check emails and newsletters regularly. It is the responsibility of the parents or adult students to inform the dance school of any address, telephone, or email address changes.

Parents are requested to ask any questions or address any concerns that they may have by email or request to schedule a meeting.

The studio is not responsible for providing care to any student before or after class. Students are not to be left at the studio for excessive time before or after class. Students should not arrive earlier than 5 minutes prior to their class and must be picked up promptly after their class has ended. REMINDER Drop off & Pick up Only.

✓ Substitutes

The studio reserves the right to provide a substitute teacher if the regularly scheduled teacher is ill or otherwise unable to teach classes. If a teacher is ill and cannot arrange a substitute the studio reserves the right to cancel the class and schedule a make up class.
