BUSINESS LICENSES AND REGISTRATIONS

As soon as you start any business, there are certain mandatory licenses and registrations that are required to run business activities smoothly. Depending upon the nature of your start-ups business, you may need to obtain licenses such as 'goods and service tax' registration, 'import-export code', 'BIS' registration or if your start-up is in a BPO business then it needs to obtain 'other service providers' registration from the Department of Technology. Similarly, for the businesses involved in food processing, manufacturing, storage, etc. needs to obtain FSSAI license.
