

# Trash Day

The Department of Public Works (DPW) Bureau of Solid Waste provides curbside trash service for city households. To get information about your trash pickup day, call 311.

## Trash Day Procedures

On trash day, or the evening before, your trash container must be placed in the location specified by DPW. If you need more information contact 311.



All trash must be inside a container with a tight fitting lid.

Trash cannot be set out in bags outside of containers, and cannot be placed at the corner or on vacant lots.



# Container Storage

Place collection containers out the night before or morning of pickup.

Return bins to storage area promptly after collection.



Trash containers cannot remain on streets, sidewalks or alleys on non-collection days.

Between trash days, all waste must be stored in a trash container with a tight fitting lid.



# Recycling Day

The Department of Public Works Bureau of Solid Waste provides recycling pickup for city households. To find out your recycling day, call 311 for information.

Baltimore City offers single stream recycling of clean:

- Paper/Cardboard
- Aluminum & steel cans
- Glass bottles & jars
- Plastic cups, containers & bottles
- Aluminum foil & pans
- Milk & juice cartons

Keep food and liquid out of your recycling container.

Place items in any box, bin or other container. Items for recycling cannot be placed in plastic bags for collection.



## Basic Tenant Responsibilities

- Prevent trash debris, and bulk trash, from accumulating near or on the property.
- Place collection containers out the night before or morning of pickup.
- Return bins to storage area promptly after collection.
- Dog waste must be cleaned up immediately and disposed of properly.

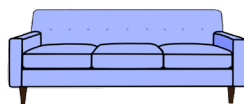


## Bulk Trash

Bulk trash collection is a **FREE** service that helps maintain the cleanliness of our city. The City will collect **up to THREE** bulk item once a month, not including holidays.
