## **INSTRUCTIONS**

Use this form to create Articles of Revival for an Alberta corporation. The completed form must be submitted to an authorized Corporate Registry Service Provider. The authorized representative of the corporation must present their identification to the service provider in order to register this information.

- Item 1. Enter the dissolved corporation's full legal name.
  - If the corporation has been dissolved for more than three years, these articles must be submitted with an
    Alberta Corporate Name Report (from the NUANS database), dated not more than 90 days from the date the
    Articles of Revival are submitted to an authorized service provider.
  - The Alberta Corporate Name Report is not required when the corporation has a number name assigned by the Registrar of Corporations.
- Item 2. The corporate access number **must** be entered. It is printed at the top of the:
  - Certificate of Incorporation.
  - · Certificate of Continuance.
  - Certificate of Amalgamation.
- Item 3. Business Number The Canada Revenue Agency Business number may be supplied, if known.
- Item 4. Enter the reasons why the corporation was dissolved, adding specific references, where possible, to the section of the *Business Corporations Act* under which it was dissolved.
- Item 5. Only interested persons, as defined by Section 206.1 of the *Business Corporations Act*, may apply to revive a corporation. Select the choice that best describes the applicant's interest/relationship to the corporation.
- Item 6. State the applicant's reasons for reviving the corporation.
- Item 7. Enter the applicant's name and complete business or home address, including the postal code.
- Item 8. Enter the first and last name of the authorized individual. The middle name is optional.
  - Select the appropriate relationship to the corporation.
  - Enter the telephone number of the signing authority.
  - Enter the email address of the signing authority.
  - Enter the date of submission.
  - Ensure the form is signed.

## These articles must be submitted with the following:

- · Annual returns not previously filed.
- Submission of a Notice of Address and Notice of Directors is recommended to confirm current information.
- Submission of a Notice of Agent for Service is required when an agent for service was not appointed prior to the corporation's dissolution.

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
