

## **Emergency Showers**

# Section 24 of the Alberta OHS Code states:

"If a worker is present at a work site where chemicals harmful to the eyes or skin are used, the employer MUST ensure that the worker has immediate access at the work site to emergency baths, showers, and eye wash equipment."



- Compliant to ANSI/ISEA Z358.1-2014 standard
- Designed to exceed all applicable codes, standards and certifications
- Constructed of welded steel and include emergency eyewash, shower, and drench hose systems
