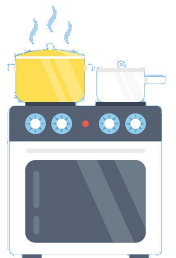

Here at Wildwood & Soundview Gardens we take safety very seriously. We encourage you to take a moment to review our fire safety tips to ensure continued safety, health and happiness for you, your neighbors and our community.

FIRE SAFETY & TENANT RESPONSIBILITY:

OVEN & STOVE SAFETY: Don't leave pots unattended on the stove and be sure to shut off the gas when you are finished cooking. Tenants should always practice AWARENESS; **never leave the stove, or oven on while unattended.** It is imperative that tenants keep appliances clean. Spilled food, grease and crumbs can be a source of fire. Clean and wipe down your appliances after each use.



TREES: We recommend using artificial, flame retardant trees during the holidays. If you choose to purchase a real tree, do not allow them to dry out. Keep them well hydrated by using a base that has a water reservoir. Discard them in the dumpsters, or recycle them as soon after the holiday as possible. Use LED bulbs rather than incandescent.



CANDLES & FLAMMABLES: We highly discourage the use of flame lit candles. Consider using battery operated flameless candles. If you must use flame lit candles please keep ALL easily flammable items at least three feet away from heat sources, including space heaters, radiators and heat vents as well as fabrics like hanging curtains. Never leave your apartment, or go to bed with candles burning. Use candle holders that are stable and made from material that cannot burn and place them where they cannot be easily knocked over.



ALL SEASON FIRE SAFETY: • Defective hair dryers, curling irons, toasters and frayed wires are a source of danger. Inspect these items regularly and unplug them when not in use. • Too many appliances running off of one outlet can cause a short circuit; use power strips with built in circuit breakers. • Please report apartment circuit breakers that pop off to the Super immediately. • Do not store any tires, flammable liquids, rags, mattresses, box springs, newspapers, or other similar items in your unit, or in the storage room(s). These dangerous items will be removed without further notice. • DO NOT SMOKE IN BED! • Contact maintenance immediately if your smoke and/or smoke/CO alarm unit does not function properly. Do not disable or remove the detectors!



WHAT TO DO IN CASE OF FIRE: Stop, Drop & Roll! Call 911 immediately and evacuate the building and then call our emergency number at 516-387-1071 to alert us. If you need to use a fire extinguisher, they are located in each of the buildings hallways. Make yourself aware of the location of these extinguishers in case you ever need it in the future.
