



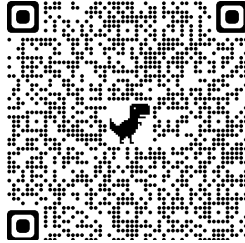

Step 1: Open link <https://page.hockeycanada.ca/page/hc/ohf/greater-toronto-hockey-league/house-league-hl/hl-york-mills-hockey-club/participant/1ebc588f-aff3-631e-8214-06185bd3bf4e> or use QR code



Step 2: Click on "Register Now"

Step 3: Create an account and password. You will need to choose an email address and create a password. **Please use the same email address with which you would like to receive YMHC House League communications.**

Step 4: Choose either "Register an existing participant" or "Register a new participant"

Step 5: If registered a new participant, fill in the required fields, name and date of birth. If registering an existing player, search for your player with either their HCR# or First name, last name and date of birth. Select player in search results.

Step 6: Participants must register in the division aligned to their year of birth. Requests for participation in a division other than year of birth must be directed to ymhcregistrar@rogers.com.

Step 7: Read and acknowledge the Waivers.

Step 8: Register another participant (repeat steps 4-7).

Step 9: Proceed to check out. Review order summary and click next. Read and acknowledge the Payment Terms and Conditions.

Step 10: Select and complete credit card payment.

Step 11: You will see a confirmation message with the invoice number. A copy of the invoice should be sent to your email. All registration and transaction history can be seen in the participant profile.

We will work to help you solve your issue, but please recognize that the system is new to YMHC as well. We appreciate your patience in this process.
